Rewards for eye exams



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Hypertension: Controlled Blood Pressure

Nearly half of American adults have high blood pressure. Monitoring and controlling blood pressure is critical for overall health and well-being. Track your patients' values through your PCP Incentive Program (PIP) reports and, when applicable, remind them they can self-report if they have an electronic blood pressure cuff to use at home and their blood pressure is documented in their Electronic Medical Record (EMR).



Osteoporosis Management in Women with a Fracture

Women who suffer a fracture are at increased risk of additional fractures and Osteoporosis. Learn how to better follow up with and monitor women who fall into this HEDIS measure's eligible population.

Flu Shots

Let your Medicare patients know they're eligible to receive a \$10 reward for getting their seasonal vaccines. This includes the flu shot and their COVID-19 booster (if applicable), which they can receive in the same appointment.

Some of your patients may receive the 2021 Health Outcomes Survey (HOS) through November. Required by CMS, the HOS assesses a patient's perceptions of their health and overall wellbeing.

Over-the-Counter (OTC) Allowance

With an OTC card, your eligible patients receive \$25-\$145 per quarter (depending on their plan) to spend on items ranging from band aids to blood pressure cuffs. Their OTC card can also help them save on healthier foods at Walmart, CVS, Kroger and Walgreens – up to \$2,500 per year.

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BrainHO

Let your Medicare patients know they have access to BrainHQ – online exercises that challenge attention, brain speed, memory and more – as part of their health plan. They can improve their cognitive function from wherever they are.
